What is an advocate?

Sometimes you might need some help sharing your voice. An advocate is someone who speaks up for other people, especially if those people are having a hard time being heard. Imagine a friend at school feels too shy to tell the teacher they need help. You can be their advocate by telling the teacher for them.

You might find that there is a time when you need help sharing your voice. You can ask anyone from Blue Sky to help you, but if you would rather speak to someone else, you can speak to someone at Help at Hand.

Complaints



Blue Sky Bear is wondering what he could do if he did not feel happy with the care his foster carers were giving him, or if he felt unsafe. You can follow the same guide if you feel unhappy or unsafe with your foster carers.

Blue Sky Bear doesn't feel happy with how his foster carers are caring for him...



He asks his foster carer, or Molly, for his social worker or a Blue Sky worker to come and visit him. He doesn't need to tell his carer why he would like a visit...



Blue Sky Bear tells the social worker what he is worried about and he is listened to...

The social worker speaks to the people who work at Blue Sky...

Blue Sky Bear's social worker speaks to his foster carers about ways to make things feel better, and then talks to him about how things can change...



If Blue Sky Bear still feels unhappy, Blue Sky will ask another social worker to try and help...

They will listen to Blue Sky Bear and try to find a way to make things feel better...



If he still isn't happy, Blue Sky will make a panel of three people that will look at his complaint again and let him know their decision...

Blue Sky Bear can phone Ofsted (who are in charge of making sure Blue Sky are doing their job and keeping you safe) whenever he needs to. This might be to make a complaint, or to share something he is worried about. Their number is 0300 123 1231, if you need help calling them, you can ask your foster carer, or someone at Blue Sky.





QUESTIONS ???

Blue Sky Bear has some questions about what it will be like living in foster care. Using your pencil, can you help him match the answers to his questions?

WHEN WILL
I
SEE MY
FAMILY?

There might be different reasons for this. You can ask your social worker who will be able to explain it to you.

WILL I GET
POCKET
MONEY?

Sleep is really important and your foster carers will let you know what time you need to go to bed.

WHEN IS
BED
TIME?

You will get pocket money from your foster carers and they will save some money for you also. You can ask them to see how much you will get.

WHY DO I
LIVE
HERE?

Your social worker will decide when you can see them, and you can ask your social worker at any time if you would like to see them.

BULLYING

If someone is picking on you, or making you feel sad, it can be very difficult and it is a good idea to tell someone about it.

Blue Sky Bear knows he should talk to someone if he is being bullied, but he's not sure who.

Can you help him find who he should talk to by completing the dot to dot? You can write the names and numbers of each person in the spaces!
